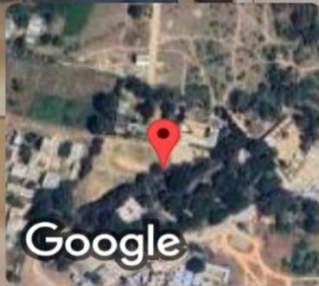

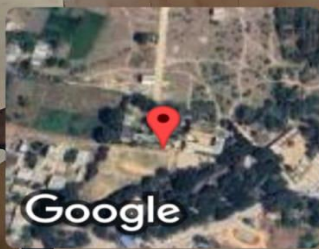
The programme concluded on a positive note with active participation from teaching and non-teaching staff, along with students, making the event both informative and meaningful.
