Date: 03.07.2025

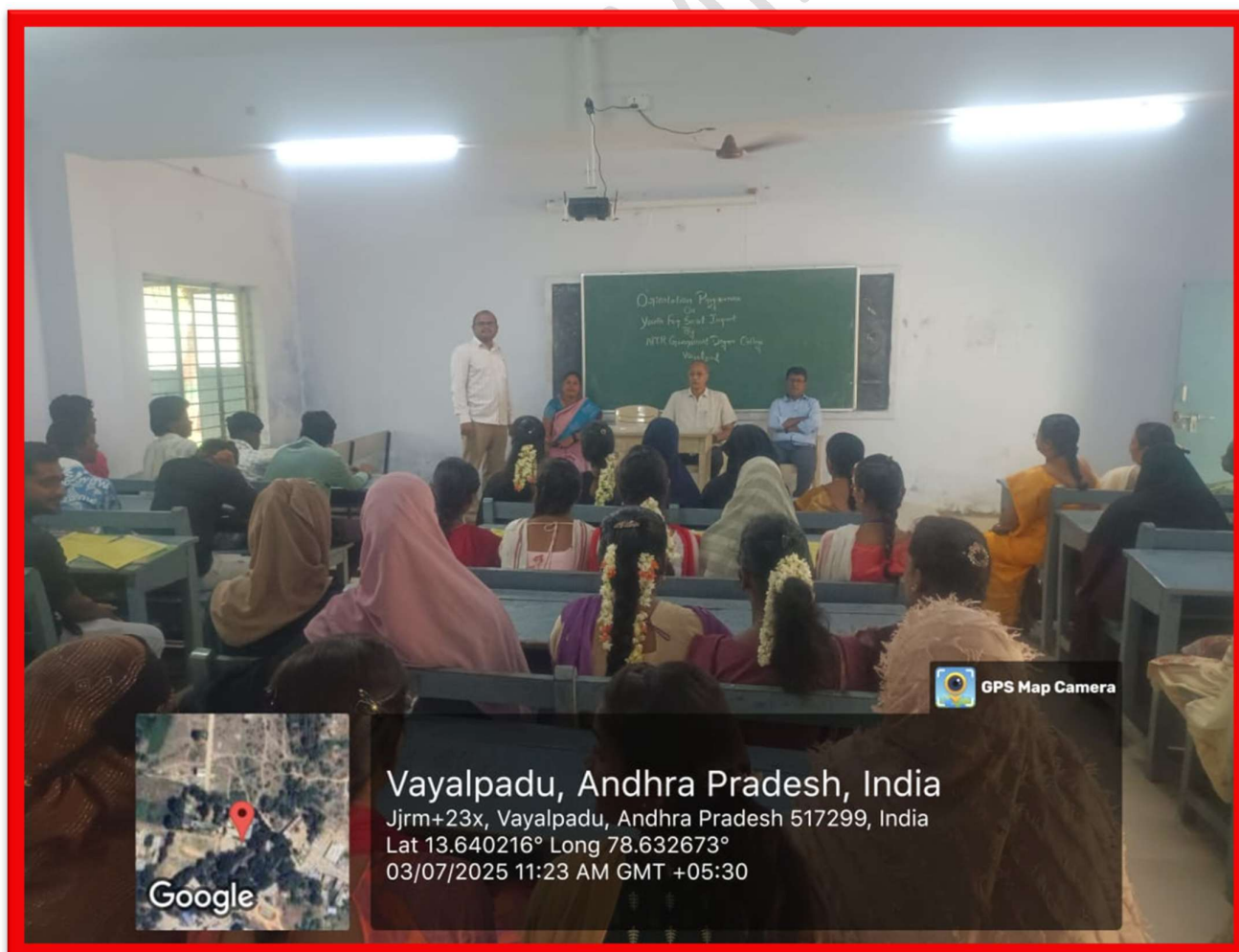
Venue: NTR Government Degree College, Valmikipuram

PLASTIC COLLECTION DRIVE

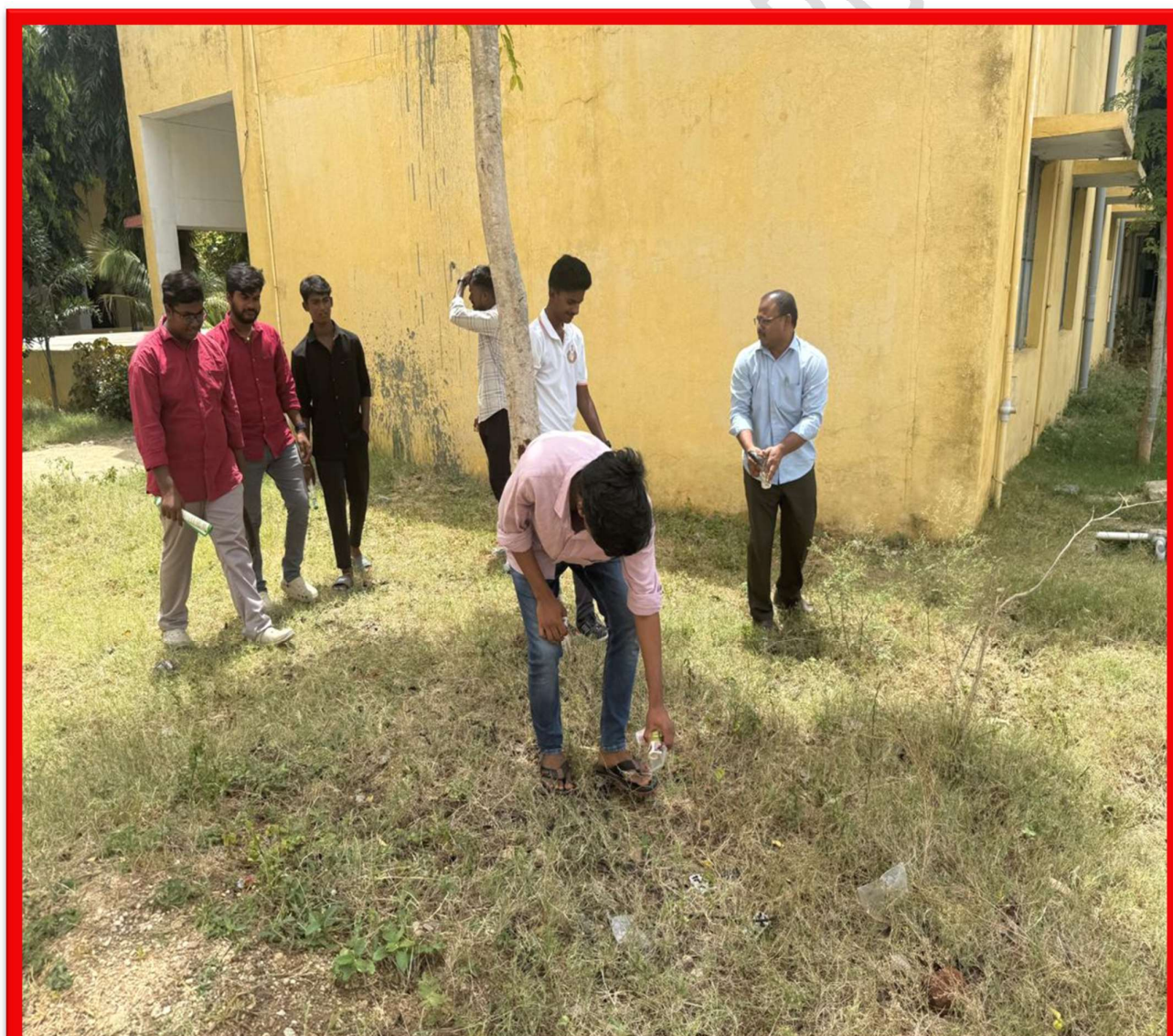
Plastic Collection Drive in View of Swachha Andhra - Swarna Andhra (SASA)

Date: 31.07.2025

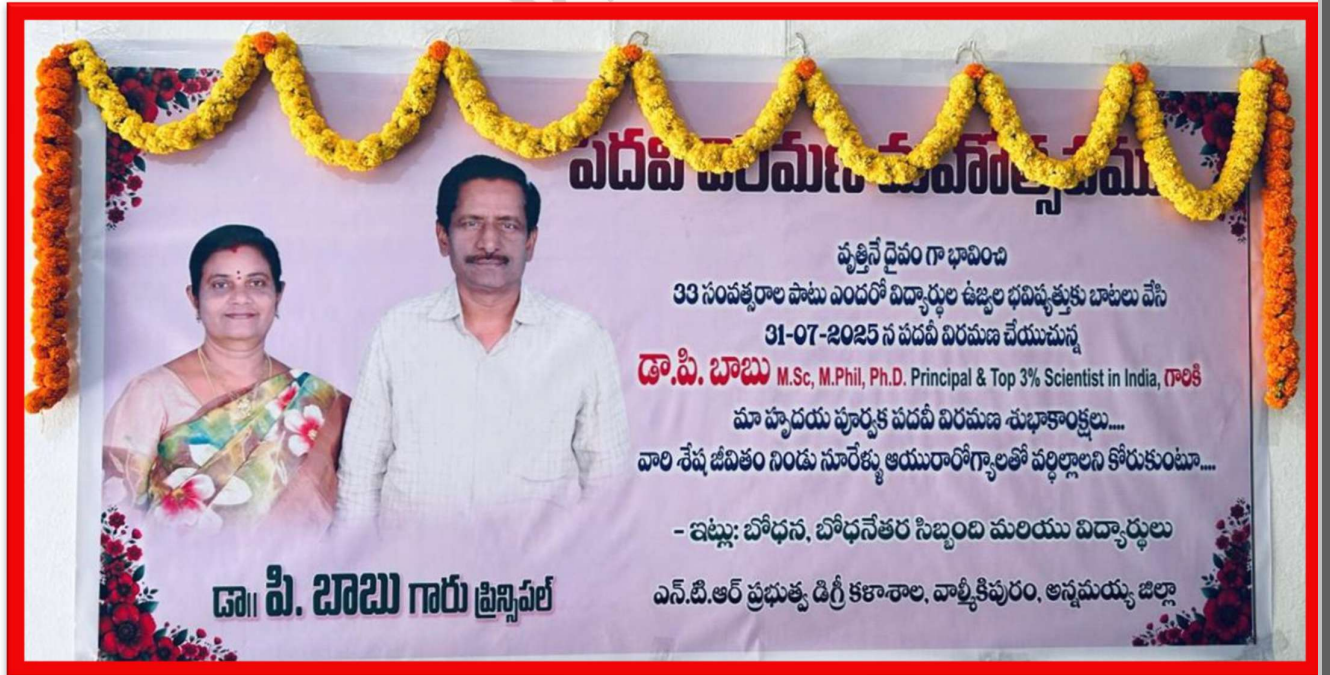
Venue: NTR Government Degree College, Valmikipuram
